WHAT ARE ADULT LEARN TO SHOOT EVENTS?

Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever's shooting sports programs were originally focused on youth initiatives, but they have now expanded in scope to serve novice recreational shooters of all ages. Through our new Path to the Uplands initiative, the adult focused LTS program aims to engage new audiences across the country to diversify our shooting sports community.

The objective of this program is

specifically designed to provide knowledge, skills, and an introduction to shooting sports, through education and interaction with experienced instructors and positive hands-on skill building activities in a controlled setting. These events allow participants to experience wingshooting, while educating them on the importance of firearm safety, conservation, and outdoor ethics. Ultimately, we want to create a Path to the Uplands that leads a new recreational shooting enthusiast to purchase a hunting license and become a part of the conservation community!

Our PF and QF Education & Outreach team can provide financial assistance and training for chapters to engage new audiences through collaborative efforts of volunteers, staff, and partners to Recruit, Retain and Reactivate more sportsmen and women.

WHAT IS THE POLLINATOR OUTREACH PROGRAM?

Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever's Pollinator Habitat Outreach Program aims to engage schools, youth groups, families and communities across the country in establishing pollinator habitat projects. The objectives of this program are to increase awareness about decreasing pollinator habitat across the country.

The program will provide tools for Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever chapters and partners to create habitat projects that involve youth groups, schools and community groups. Program support includes training on how to plan and conduct a pollinator project from start to finish, conservation/pollinator curriculum for classrooms, hands-on educational activities, and monitoring

activities that can be conducted after the project is established.

In addition, grants up to \$500 are available to help with project expenses. The results of this program will not only benefit pollinators by providing quality foraging and nesting habitat, but it'll provide opportunities for youth to get outside and gain an appreciation for wildlife and conservation.
